

PRIVACY POLICY

Thank you for visiting this website (this “Site”) owned and operated by Folio Clinical Research Organization LLC . (“FOLIO” “we,” “us,” and “our”).

Scope of This Policy

This online privacy policy (this “Policy”) applies only to information collected through the website on which it is posted. It does not apply to third-party platforms, other FOLIO-operated websites, or other FOLIO-operated platforms on which it is not posted. It also does not apply to information collected through other channels, such as over the phone or in person, or as part of a clinical study.

This Policy may be supplemented or amended from time to time by additional privacy notices (“Privacy Notices”), provided at the time we collect your information. For example, certain pages of this Site may contain Privacy Notices providing more details about the information we collect on those particular pages, why we need that information, and your choices about how we use that information. In other cases, specific Privacy Notices may be required to comply with the privacy laws of one of the countries, provinces, or states in which we do business.

Your Choices

In General. We respect your right to choose how we collect, use, and disclose your information. This Policy describes some of your choices, such as opting out of receiving “cookies.” We may ask you to indicate your choices at the time and on the page where you provide your information.

Information We Collect

Personal Information You Provide.

FOLIO collects the information you provide when you use this Site. For example, we collect the information you provide if you choose to complete a pre-screening questionnaire, contact us with questions, or otherwise interact with this Site. Some of the information you may choose to provide will be personal information, such as your name and contact information, whether you are of a certain age, and other information regarding your qualifications for a clinical study.

Information From Your Browser or Device.

FOLIO collects information sent to us automatically by your web browser or mobile device. This information may include your IP address, the name of your operating system, the name and version of your browser, the date and time of your visit, and the pages you visit. The information we receive may depend on your browser or device settings. The information we receive from your web browser and device may not be, in and of itself, personally identifiable. However, we may combine it with other information to identify you, or we may combine it with information that does identify you.

Information Collected by Cookies and Other Technologies.

We use “cookies” and other technologies to collect information and support certain features of this Site. For example, we may use these technologies to:

- Collect information about how visitors use this Site—which pages they visit, which links they use, and how long they stay on each page.
- Support the features and functionality of this Site—for example, to save you the trouble of reentering information already in our database or to prompt the settings you established on previous visits.
- Personalize your experience when you use this Site; and Improve our marketing efforts, including targeted advertising.

If you do not wish to receive cookies, you may set your browser to reject cookies or to alert you when a cookie is placed on your computer. Although you are not required to accept cookies when you visit this Site, you may be unable to use all of its functionality if your browser rejects our cookies.

Third Party Sources.

We may combine personal information we receive from you with information we obtain from other sources such as our pages on social media sites. When you interact with our social media pages, we will collect information that you elect to provide to us, such as your contact details. We may also obtain personal information from other third parties, such as marketing partners, publicly available sources and data brokers. The third-party’s privacy policy will

apply to your interactions and their collection, use and processing of your personal information.

Information About Third-Party Cookies

In addition to the cookies FOLIO delivers to your computer or mobile device through this Site, certain third parties may deliver cookies to you for various reasons. For example, we use Google Analytics, which helps us understand how visitors engage with our Sites..

Other third parties may deliver cookies to your computer or mobile device to track your online behaviors over time and across nonaffiliated websites and/or deliver targeted advertisements on this Site or on other websites.

You have choices about third-party information collection on our Sites. For example, if you don't want information about your visit to this Site sent to Google Analytics, you may download an Opt-out Browser Add-on. Please note that the Add-on does not prevent information from being sent to FOLIO.

In addition, if you would like to opt out of having interest-based information collected by certain entities during your visits to this Site or other websites, industry-developed website that contains mechanisms for choosing whether each listed entity may collect and use data for online behavioral advertising purposes. How We Use Your Information

Service delivery. We will use your personal information in connection with our services, including identifying potential participants for a FOLIO Trial, responding to your inquiries or requests, providing and improving the content on our Site, and communicating information regarding our relationship with you or our research or products. We also use the collected data to monitor Site usage, provide analysis or information to improve the Site, and detect, prevent and address technical issues.

For research and development. We may use your personal information for research and development purposes, including analyzing and improving our Site and our business. As part of these activities, we may create aggregated, de-identified, or other anonymous data from the personal information we collect. We make personal information into anonymous data by removing information that makes the data personally identifiable to you. We may use this anonymous data and share it with third parties for our lawful business purposes, including analyzing and improving our Site and promoting our business.

Compliance and protection. We may use your personal information to:

- Comply with applicable laws, lawful requests, and legal process, such as to respond to subpoenas or requests from government authorities;
- Protect our, your or others' rights, privacy, safety or property (including by making and defending legal claims);
- Audit our internal processes for compliance with legal and contractual requirements and internal policies;
- Enforce the terms and conditions that govern the Site; and
- Prevent, identify, investigate and deter fraudulent, harmful, unauthorized, unethical or illegal activity, including cyberattacks and identity theft.
- Marketing and advertising. We and our advertising partners may collect and use your personal information for marketing and advertising purposes, including:
 - Direct marketing. From time to time, we may send you direct marketing communications as permitted by law. You may opt out of our marketing communications as described in the communication or by contacting us.
 - Interest-based advertising. We engage our advertising partners, including third-party advertising and social media companies, to display ads around the web. These companies may use cookies and similar technologies to collect information about your interactions over time across our Site, our communications and other online services, and use that information to serve online ads that they think will interest you. How We Share Your Information

With Third-Party Vendors. FOLIO shares information collected through this Site with third-party vendors who act for us or on our behalf, including Credent Partners USA, LLC. Credent Partners USA, LLC designed and operates this Site, conducts surveys and clinical studies and helps us with our promotional efforts. These third-party vendors may need information about you to perform their functions on our behalf. We require our third-party service providers and vendors to restrict their use of personally identifiable information from our Site to the intended purposes.

With Third-Party Social Media Platforms and other Advertising Partners. We may also use third-party social media platforms or other advertising partners to offer you interest-based ads. To offer such ads, we may convert your email address into a unique value which our

partner company can match with a user on their platform. Although we do not provide any personal information to these platform vendors, they may gain insights about individuals who respond to the ads we serve.

To determine Your Eligibility for a Clinical Study. If you choose to provide information through our Site to see if you qualify to participate in a clinical study, we may share your information with business partners or potential study center(s) so that they may contact you to see if you are a suitable candidate for one of our clinical studies. We require such business partners or potential study centers to restrict their use of any personally identifiable information received through our Site to the intended purposes.

Professional Advisors. We may disclose your personal information to professional advisors, such as lawyers, bankers, auditors and insurers, where necessary in the course of the professional services that they render to us.

In Aggregate or De-Identified Form. We use information collected through this Site to create a compiled, aggregate view of usage patterns. We may share aggregate information with third parties for various purposes, including so they can better understand our user base. We may also share information about how particular individuals use this Site with third parties, but only on a de-identified basis (“Individualized Data”). Individualized Data is not personally identifiable, but it does reflect the usage patterns of a particular Site user, as opposed to Site users collectively. For clarity, we may use and share aggregated or de-identified data without restriction.

As Part of a Business Transfer. Your information may be transferred to a successor organization if, for example, we transfer the ownership or operation of this Site to another organization or if we merge with another organization or liquidate our assets. If such a transfer occurs, the successor organization’s use of your information will still be subject to this Policy and the privacy preferences you have expressed.

To Comply with Laws and Protect Our Rights and the Rights of Others. We may disclose your information for the “Compliance and protection” purposes described above.

As Described in a Privacy Notice or Click-Through Agreement. We may disclose your information as described in any Privacy Notice posted on a page of this Site where you provide that information or in any click-through agreement to which you have agreed.

How We Protect Your Information

FOLIO takes reasonable precautions to provide a level of security appropriate to the sensitivity of the information we collect. Hypertext Transfer Protocol Secure (HTTPS) is a variant of the standard web transfer protocol (HTTP) that adds a layer of security on the data in transit through a secure socket layer (SSL) or transport layer security (TLS) protocol connection. This Site, questionnaire forms on the Site and our backup site are all HTTPS, meaning all information and data is fully encrypted end-to-end. Although we use reasonable

measures to help protect your information against unauthorized use or disclosure, we cannot guarantee the security of the information supplied over the Internet or stored in our databases. Some security breaches are beyond our reasonable control.

Children's Privacy

The Site is not intended for children under 13 years of age. We do not knowingly collect, use or disclose personal information about visitors under 13. If you are under 13, please do not use this Site. If we learn we have collected or received personal information from a child under 13 without verification of parental consent, we will delete that information.
